- The rest of the values have to do with me and my well being.

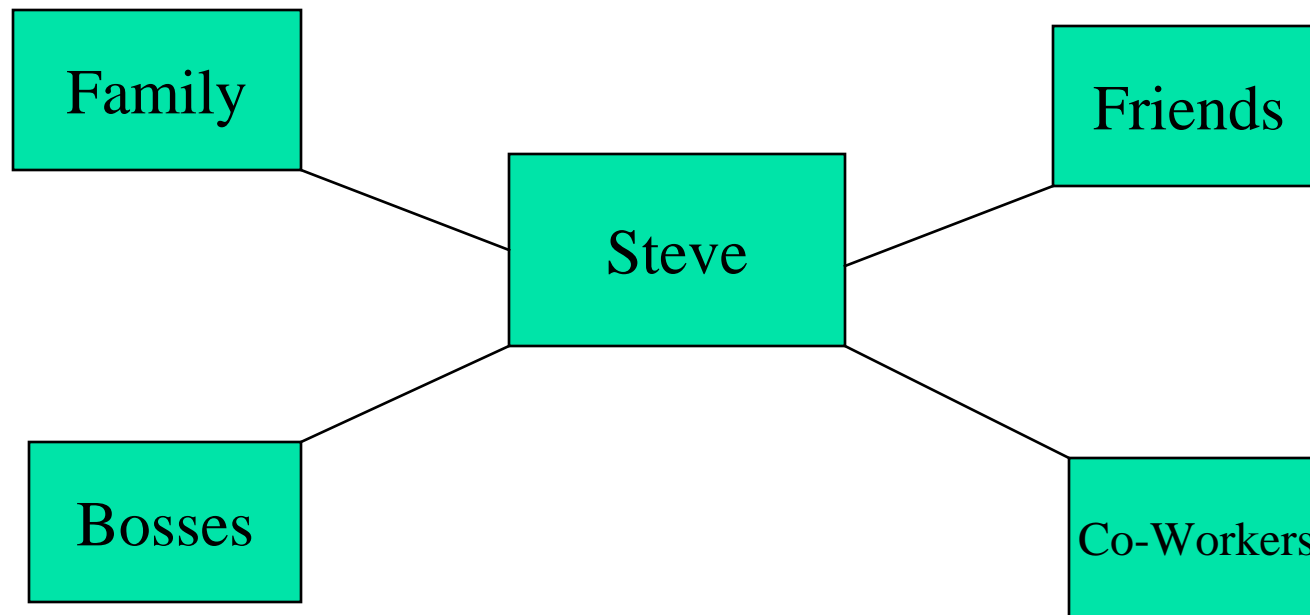


Stakeholders/Power/Importance
