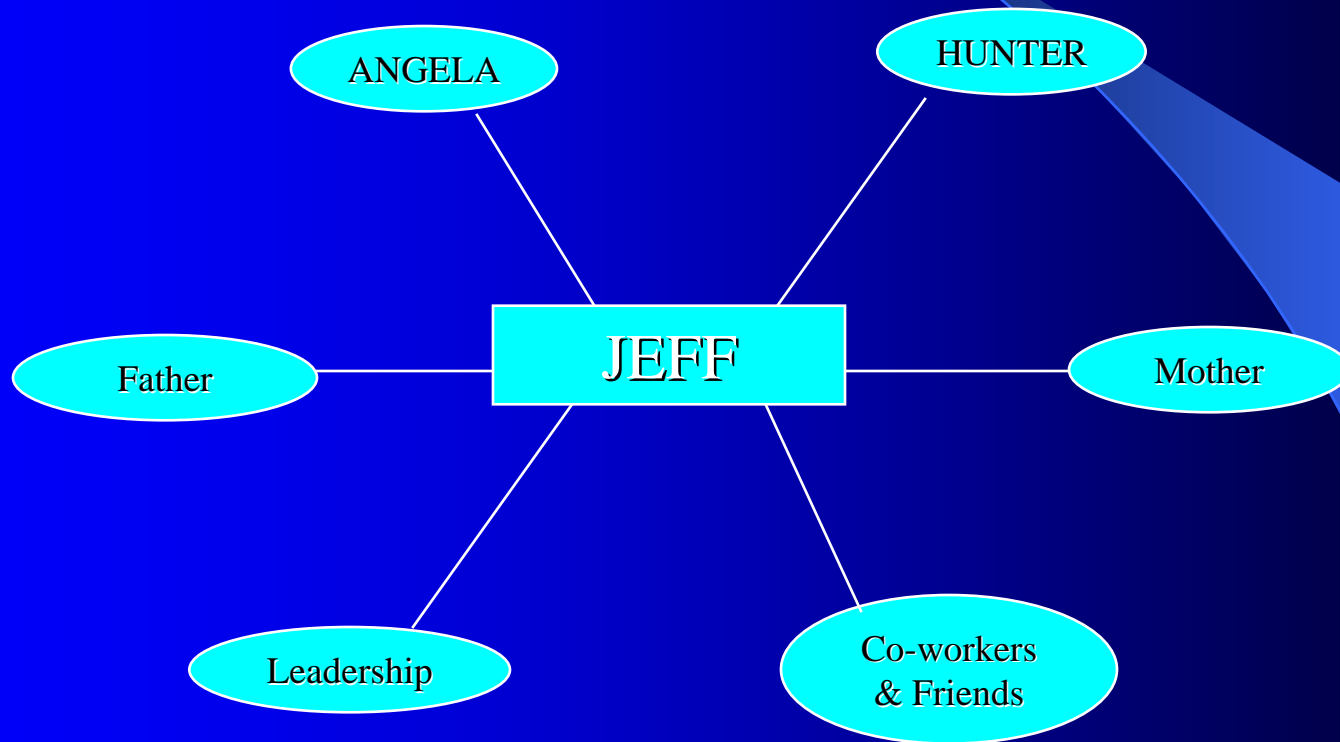
Values
